General Meeting Minutes

October 16, 2019

Call to Order at 6:05pm

Quorum met.

President Report – Ruth Mendez

Welcome and sign in. Free dress bracelets can be used Friday, Oct 18th

Treasurer Report – Tracy Liswesky

Financial Reconciliation- Ending balance \$107,000. As of Sunday, we have spent 16K. Spending money on teacher grants. Opened up \$750 grants to teachers. Reconciliation is a check of books. 2017/2018 revealed we need to be more rigorous with use of the debit card. Not going with credit card. Voted debit card and use needs 2 approvals. Documented use of debit card. Theater club has an opportunity for volunteer hours. Agreed to a pass-through line item – will not incur extra expenses. Will receive matching gifts.

The following items were presented at the general meeting:

- o Supplement Article VI FINANCIAL POLICIES 6.02 Banking to include the following: The Frank Black Middle School PTO may also have a debit card for its checking account. A debit card may only be used by the Treasurer or his/her delegate to pay for an approved expenditure with agreement in writing from another authorized signer on the checking account; provided that the foregoing persons may not process or agree to use of the debit card if they have a direct or indirect interest in the expenditure.
- Reduce Teacher Development budget by \$1,300.
- Note: This reduction is supported by Principal Honore because she has a budget line for professional development. This item is included in this Emergency Vote because the money will be used to fund the FBMS mentor program (see item 2 below). This program has already kicked off so money to help pay for the uniforms for the program is requested ASAP.
 - Create a new line item to the FBMS PTO budget for student mentor program and fund this line item with a budget of \$1,300.00.
- Note: The \$1,300.00 will be used to pay for a portion of the cost of the uniforms for the students who participate in Rogers University, an FBMS mentor program. This program has already kicked off so money to help pay for the uniforms for the program is requested ASAP. This mentor program will be lead by HISD FBMS counselor Brandon Rogers. The program will be titled Rogers University. It is a campus based and led program with consistent and daily contact with about 25 scholars. This program will allow for leadership possibilities prior to high school and college. Mr. Rogers has already secured 7 volunteers to serve as mentors for this program.
 - Add a line item to the FBMS budget titled "Theater Club Pass-through" with a budget of \$0 to the 2019-2020 budget.

Note: This is included in the emergency vote because the license for the Spring Musical must be purchased ASAP. This is a one-time line item to the FBMS budget. Our Fine Arts Liaison requested this line item to solicit sponsors for the 2020 Spring Musical, with the intent that they will formalize a Booster club for next year.

Monies donated to this line item will be spent entirely on the Spring Musical. The PTO will incur no extra income or expenses as a result of this vote.

Community in Schools – Amanda Rhodes

Non-profit. 501c-3 housed inside of schools, offer resources for all students-enrichment/academic/counseling/teacher assistance. Year round/catered to the child's needs. Consent forms available. Individual and group sessions. Teacher recommended, student initiated, self-referred. Academics, behavior, attendance, home-life.
